Albert Glen Haley, 57, passed away on Thursday, December 26, 2024, at Sanctuary Hospice in Tupelo, MS. 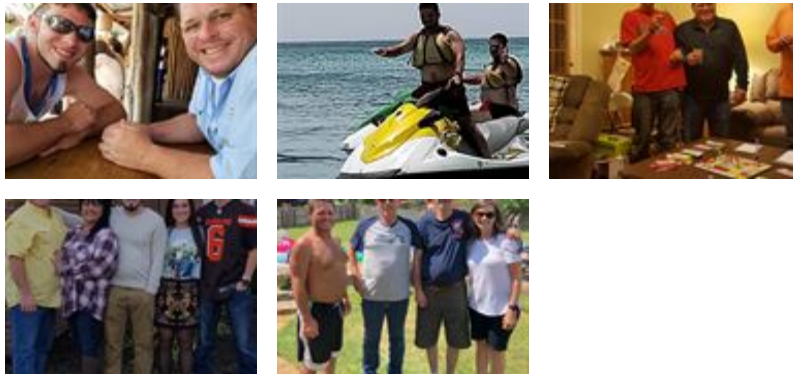

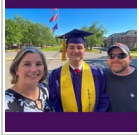
