Jerry Nelson Goode, 81, of Olive Branch, Mississippi, passed away peacefully on January 25, 2026, in Olive Branch. 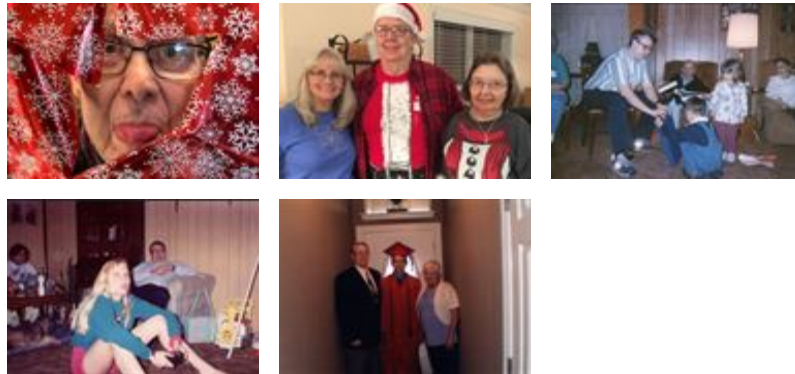
