Teddi.

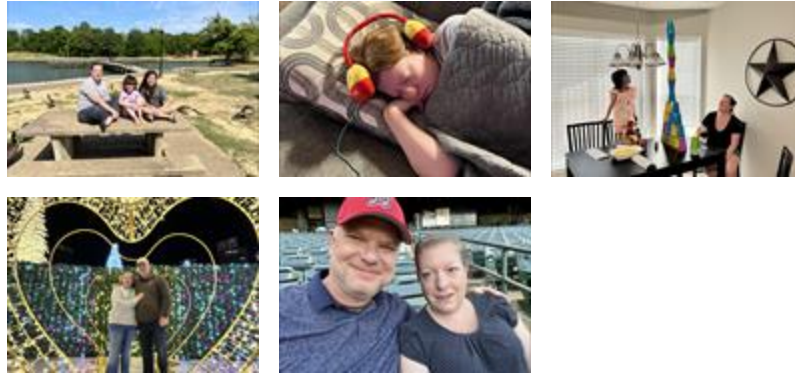
Michelle's kindness, humor, and vibrant spirit will be deeply missed, but her legacy of love and laughter will live on in the hearts of all who knew her.

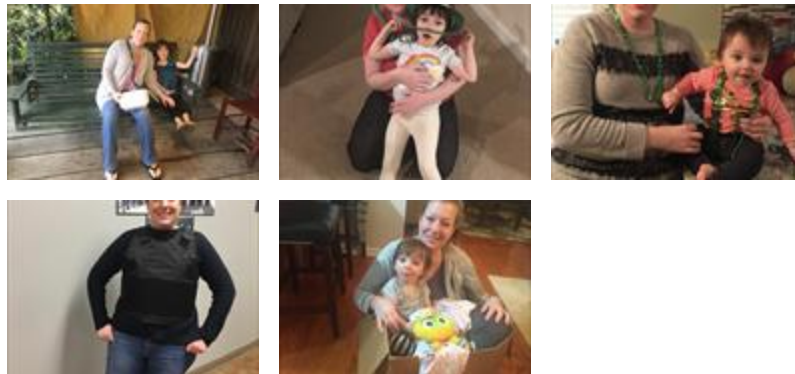
