NASCAR fan throughout his life. Charlie was deeply loved by his family and friends and will be greatly missed by all who knew him.

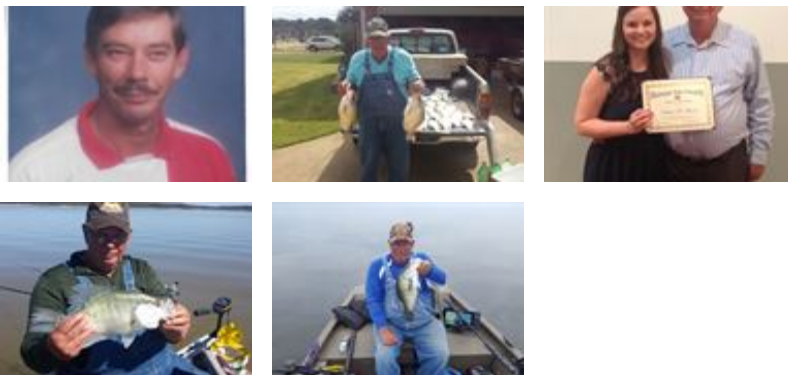

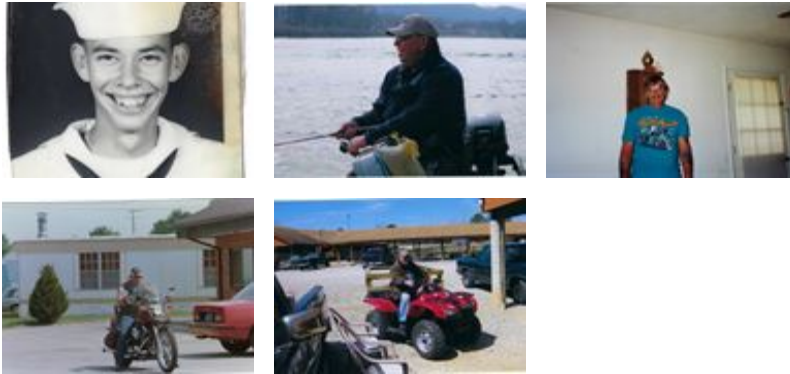
