Lieutenant Ronnie Eugene Flanigan, 62, of Olive Branch, passed away on Friday, April 18, 2025. 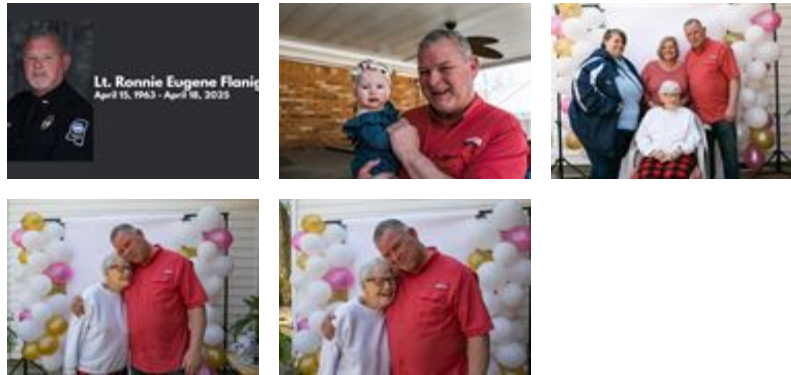
