Sidney Lee Carey, 75, of Olive Branch, MS, passed away on October 25, 2024. Sid was born on January 6, 1949 in Richmond, VA to the late Samuel Sidney and Pauline White Carey. He was married to the love of his life, Donna, for 40 years. Sid graduated from Lambuth College in Jackson TN, obtaining a bachelor's degree in Business Administration. After college, he went to work for Internal Revenue Service and retired after 33 years. Sid and Donna have attended Getwell Church for the past 38 years. Sid's faith and participation in church and Sunday School were very important to him.

In his early twenties, Sid developed a passion for antique cars. He enjoyed restoring an old car back to the original, seeking advice and help from his car buddies. Sid entered his cars in shows, won several best of show awards, and enjoyed serving as a judge at car shows. He enjoyed touring with cars and especially his friendships with other "old car" guys. Sid served as a past

president of Memphis Antique Car Club and Mid-America Old Time Automobile Association. He also held memberships in the Model A Ford Club of America and the Vintage Chevrolet Club of America. His 1931 Chevrolet remains on display at the Museum of Automobiles on Petit Jean Mountain, AR.

Another favorite hobby was woodworking. For the last several years, Sid spent time under his friend's guidance creating items for his home including furniture, clocks, bowls, a mantel, etc.
